
















# Celebrating Forty Years of Supporting Cancer Research

### About the Glenn Anderson Day of Golf for the Cross Cancer Institute



This year marks the 40th anniversary of the Glenn Anderson Day of Golf. Our tournament has raised nearly \$20 million for Alberta cancer research, treatments/equipment, and patient care thanks to the support of our generous donors, volunteers, golfers, and partners.

It all began in 1985 when Edmonton Oilers superstar Glenn Anderson sought new ways to support his local community.

During that hockey season, Acklands Grainger offered to donate a thousand dollars to the Cross Cancer Institute for every goal that Glenn scored. Cal Nichols, a former partowner of the Edmonton Oilers, agreed to match the donation. Glenn scored over 50 goals that season, leading to a \$100,000 donation to the Cross.

Building on that success, discussions began about having a golf tournament to raise additional funds for cancer research. Cal Nichols used his business connections to find sponsors for the event. The inaugural tournament attracted 154 golfers and raised \$55,000.



The Glenn Anderson Day of Golf has gone on to help fund revolutionary made-in-Alberta cancer research and treatments, such as the groundbreaking Linac-MR.

None of this would have been possible without our incredible long-time supporters, whose dedication and commitment have made a lasting impact in the fight against cancer.

# What is Immunotherapy?

Immunotherapy is revolutionizing cancer treatment by taking a bold, innovative approach distinct from chemotherapy, radiation, and surgery—the traditional options for the past 50 years. Dr. Chu, a clinician scientist working at the Cross Cancer Institute, explains, "Immunotherapy is a new way of attacking cancer."

Cancer develops when it outsmarts the body's immune system, rendering it unable to fight back. Immunotherapy reawakens the immune system, enabling it to recognize and destroy cancer cells once more.



One cutting-edge form of immunotherapy, chimeric

antigen receptor (CAR) T-cell therapy, takes the patient's T-cells and genetically manipulates them to add chimeric antigen receptors onto them. This acts as a new barcode reader, helping the T-cell recognize cancer and activating the T-cell. Once the immune system can identify cancer cells again, the host has a better chance of fighting the disease.

This year, proceeds from the Day of Golf Tournament will in part support the creation of a state-of-the-art immunotherapy lab at the Cross Cancer Institute. Establishing immunotherapy infrastructure in Alberta will drastically reduce treatment costs, making life-saving options accessible to children and adults battling cancer.
